


What is the risk/return profile of your portfolio?

When assessing the performance of your investment portfolio, one should look at both risk and return. In this Fact sheet, we outline what our study of 40 years of financial performance (i.e. 1 January 1979 - 31 December 2020) tells us about the risk/return profiles of five commonly used diversified portfolios. But remember, while past performance is instructive it isn't an accurate indicator of future performance.


